This workshop is to share and to follow up the final main results of the *Entrefish* project (ref. EASME/EMFF/2016/1.2.1.2./04/SI2.750011) a project funded within the "Blue Careers" Call, launched by EASME, the Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises of the EU Commission, to promote employment and development in the "Blue Economy".

*Entrefish* is for entrepreneurs, workers, university students to foster a sustainable entrepreneurship in aquaculture and fisheries.
